Topic: Action Track Chair

Question: Does Prosthetic Sensory Aids Service (PSAS) provide the Action Track Chair?

<u>Answer:</u> Yes. Action Track Chairs are a type of all-terrain wheelchair. PSAS does provide both the Eagle and Falcon Track Chair series. Both are FDA cleared.

PSAS may provide this item when proper medical justification and documentation are provided. Documentation must indicate the medical necessity and validate that the item is an essential part of the Veteran's treatment plan.

The requesting clinician must indicate the medical diagnosis and treatment plan that involves the Veteran using the item and any necessary follow up to ensure proper usage of the item and ongoing effectiveness. The clinician must document the device has been trialed and determined to be effective and identify the anticipated objective outcome measure to determine ongoing effectiveness. Consults for this item should be placed by providers who are qualified and competent in prescribing wheeled mobility devices.

The recommended HCPCS code assigned for these devices is K0898 – Power Wheelchair Not Otherwise Classified
